Mississippi Organ Recovery Agency would like to inform you of our scholarship program for Mississippi senior high school graduates. **Eleven** scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$500.00 each and **one** scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 to deserving students who apply for the scholarship and fulfill the requirements listed below. You do not have to be a registered donor to apply for the scholarship.

Scholarship Guidelines

1. The student must be a graduating senior from an accredited Mississippi high school.
2. After graduation from high school, the student must be accepted by or have intentions of fall enrollment in either a junior college or university in the state of Mississippi.
3. A GPA of 2.5 or higher will be required.
4. Two letters of recommendation: one from a school teacher and one from an adult of your choice.
5. An essay of 300 to a maximum of 750 words will be required on one of the following topics:
 - a. Why you are a registered organ and tissue donor
 - b. The importance of encouraging others to be an organ and tissue donor
 - c. How have you or your family been affected by organ and tissue donation or by transplantation of an organ and/or tissue
 - d. Why you want to be an organ and tissue donor
